

Equipment List for Yellowstone Trip

May 20th – 25th, 2019

Because of the length and nature of the trip, adequate preparation and safety of the students in the priority. All students must have the following items. You are allowed one bag for clothing, one bag for sleeping bag, a cot and a day pack.

Equipment Pack items:

All of these items need to be in the Science Room on Wednesday, May 15th, and the equipment will be checked for quality on Thursday, May 16th during class. Only starred (*) item will be checked on May 16th.

Do not pack any food, or toiletry items with your clothing. No food or toiletry items are allowed in the tents.

- * _____ Suitcase or bag for items
- * _____ A warm sleeping bag, or lighter bag with extra blankets rolled up inside.
- * _____ One pair of waterproof hiking boots. Tennis Shoes can't be worn on day hikes.
_____ Tennis shoes for around camp
- * _____ Sleeping mat, or air mat or cot (No oversized cots)
- * _____ Rain Coat (rain pants optional) Plastic bags are not rain coats
- * _____ Stocking cap and winter gloves
- * _____ Baseball cap or hat with a brim to cover your face on hikes
- * _____ Plastic cup with a lid (will be transferred to bus or day pack)
- * _____ Knife, fork and spoon (will be transferred to bus or day pack)
- * _____ Small flashlight
- _____ Swim Suit (Possible opportunity to go swimming)
- _____ Long underwear or sweat pants
- _____ At least 10 pair of socks
- _____ At least 2 pair of jeans (shorts are not allowed on hikes but can be worn at camp)
- _____ 2 Sweaters or sweat shirts (long sleeved preferred)
- _____ 2 long sleeved shirts
- _____ 5 T-shirts
- * _____ Towel and wash cloth (for shower days)

Day Pack items: To be brought to school on Monday morning, May 20th.

These items can be brought to school on Monday morning. During the day in Yellowstone you will carry your day pack. It will include the items below, plus rain coat, extra sweater, socks, & hat and gloves.

- _____ Two lunches for the first day, we don't set up the kitchen on the first day
- _____ \$20 – \$25.00 of spending money, ice cream mostly
- _____ Tooth brush, comb, toothpaste – all morning and shower stuff (to be left on the bus at night)
- _____ Necessary Medication
- _____ pens or pencils – to fill out Yellowstone Book, journal and drawings
- _____ Water bottles – at least 2 liters of water for every hike
- _____ Toilet paper in a zip-lock bag

- _____ sun screen and chap stick
- _____ cell phone (used only for calling home & pictures)
- _____ Camera
- _____ bug spray
- _____ walking stick
- _____ Sun glasses
